



Magnolia West High School Band & Color Guard Booster Club 2022 Richard Wilkie Scholarship Application

Magnolia West High School Band & Color Guard Booster Club has established senior scholarships in memory of former band director Richard Wilkie.

The 2021-2022 Magnolia West High School Band & Color Guard Booster Club has established the following guidelines regarding the Richard Wilkie Scholarship:

1. The Scholarship Committee, comprised of community and school leaders, will select scholarship recipients. All scholarship applicants will remain anonymous to the Scholarship Committee.
2. The applicant must be a senior attending Magnolia West High School.
3. The applicant must be an active member of the Magnolia West Band or Color Guard as a senior and have all dues and fees paid in full prior to the scholarship deadline.
4. The applicant must have been in band or color guard for at least three (3) years.
5. These scholarships will be distributed based on scores received on applications.
6. The scholarship recipient must pass all spring semester classes their senior year. The scholarship will be revoked in the event that the recipient fails any spring semester class.
7. The scholarship recipients must provide the Magnolia West High School Band & Color Guard Booster Club all necessary information to demonstrate valid enrollment in an institution of higher learning for Fall 2022. This can be a university, community college, trade school, etc. The deadline for submitting this documentation is 11/1/2022. Failure to make this deadline will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
8. Scholarships will be granted according to the amount allotted by the Band & Color Guard Booster Club Scholarship Fund through fundraising and donations during the school year. Scholarship amounts may change each year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A complete application must contain all the following parts:

1. An official sealed high school transcript through the first semester of senior year
2. Completed Personal Data page
3. 2 Original essays
4. Resume of Activities, Honors/Awards, Community Service

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

ORIGINAL ESSAY SECTION INSTRUCTIONS

The Original Essays will **consist of two essays**, each with a limit of 500 words. Refer to "Essay Format" below for specific formatting instruction.

Essay I Prompt (500 words max)

What have you gained from being a member of the Magnolia West Band and Color Guard? How would you motivate someone to be an active member of Magnolia West Band and Color Guard?

Essay II Prompt (500 words max)

What would the scholarship mean to you? Where do you see yourself in 5 to 10 years?

Essay Format

- **Do NOT put your name on your Original Essays.**
- Student ID number must be at the top of each page of the Essays.
- Essays cannot be handwritten. Computers are available in the library for use if not available at home.
- Page numbers must be located at the bottom of each page.
- Each essay must be on a separate page.

RESUME SECTION INSTRUCTIONS

Include activities/accomplishments, honors/awards, as well as community service activities and other work experience, both inside and outside of school. Feel free to include a brief description of the items to showcase what you have done and any leadership roles taken.

- **Do NOT put your name on this Document.**
- Include your Student ID number at the top of the page.
- This document is limited to one (1) page, so prioritize the items to show what is most important to you.
